**(Community Service Block Grant)**

To date, Fremont CSBG dollars have helped 130 families for emergency assistance. The grant will end February 28, 2008. Fremont has spent \$39, 499 (100% of their funding). Chaffee County has spent \$10,750.71 (45% of their funding). Custer County spent \$4,040.62 (67%); and Lake County spent \$5,322.41 (77%). These reimbursements include expenses from May to December of 2007. Audrey Sandefur and I have monitored both Chaffee and Custer counties regarding the CSBG funding. The monitoring for Lake County is to be determined. It has been difficult this year to coordinate with the other counties in regards to getting their funding spent, and in receiving the proper documentation required for the next grant cycle (i.e. Tripartite Board meetings, public hearings scheduled). We anticipate strengthening our relationship in order to make this process a little easier next grant cycle.

**Transportation**

We are in the beginning of our new CDOT 5311 funding for 2008-2009. Both sub-recipients, Wet Mountain Valley and Neighbor to Neighbor were monitored by Audrey Sandefur and me, as well as by CDOT and a consultant in December. Both providers have seen an increase in ridership, and continue to do very well in Custer and Chaffee Counties.
