WHAT TO KNOW WHEN YOU RECYCLE:

BROWN GLASS: Bottles and jars only. Rinse and remove lids - labels are okay. NO dishes, mirrors, light bulbs, window, and drinking or auto-glass to the recycling site. These different types of glass melt at different temperatures and will contaminate everything.

CLEAR & GREEN GLASS: Bottles and jars only. Rinse and remove lids - labels are okay. NO dishes, mirrors, light bulbs, window, auto or drinking glass to the recycling site. These different types of glass melt at different temperatures and will contaminate everything.

ALUMINUM & TIN: Please rinse. Labels and lids are fine. To conserve space in the recycling containers, please flatten the cans. Aluminum foil is acceptable ONLY if there is no food residue.

NEWSPAPER: All inserts are acceptable. Newspapers should not be in plastic bags or bound with twine. It is not necessary to remove any staples. We will accept magazines and catalogs in the newspaper bin (note: this is just in the Westcliffe newspaper bins).

FOLLOW THESE STEPS TO RECYCLE PLASTIC:

- 1) Check for a number within a triangle. This tells what kind of plastic it is made of and indicates the recycling process required. If there is no number or triangle, find a good use for it, or throw it in the trash.
- 2) Empty and rinse both the container and the top.
- 3) Separate #1s, #2s and combine #3-#7s and bag and label them accordingly.
- 4) Bring separately bagged and tagged plastics to the recycling event.
