UAACOG receives Community Service Block Grant (CSBG) funding. This is Federal funding that is given to the State of Colorado through the Office of Community Services. The State of Colorado then grants that funding to local agencies. Our agency is a recipient of this important funding. With this funding we serve Fremont and Chaffee Counties and subgrant a portion of the funding to Lake County Public Health and Custer County Department of Human Services. The purpose of this funding is to alleviate the causes and conditions of poverty. Currently our scope of services offers assistance with rent, mortgage, utilities (to include propane and firewood), medical costs, dental costs, minor car and home repairs. This funding has proven to be a valuable resource for the citizens in the four counties that we serve. With glowing and humbling customer service feedback, this funding has proven to improve the lives that received the benefit of the program. From eviction and foreclosure avoidance to improved physical and financial well-being. Currently this program offers to income qualified families a maximum grant of \$1000.00 once in five years paid directly to vendors. We also partner with other internal and external programs and agencies to further assist a client/family's needs. These programs include Area Agency on Aging, Loaves and Fishes Ministries, Fremont County Sheriff's Office Victims Advocacy, Chaffee County COC, Section 8, Colorado Workforce Center, Head Start and more.

During the pandemic, the Office of Community Services provided additional funding to further support low-income individuals and families. This funding was called Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act, also knowns as CARES. This funding was used to further support our four counties during an unprecedented time. CARES funding offered income qualified individuals and families a maximum grant of \$1500.00. The last of this funding was spent in 2022.
